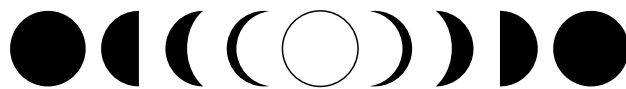

A TOTAL ECLIPSE IS RARE AND OCCURS WHEN THE MOON ALIGNS PERFECTLY WITH THE SUN AND THE EARTH.

The total solar eclipse in Henry County is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to witness a phenomenon with your family and neighbors on April 8. It will be the only total solar eclipse visible from Henry County in the next 375 years, making it a truly unique and unforgettable experience.



THE TOTAL ECLIPSE WILL LAST FOR AN AVERAGE OF 4 MINUTES IN HENRY COUNTY.

This results in a brief period of darkness known as totality, where the Sun's outer atmosphere, the corona, becomes visible. Total solar eclipses are mesmerizing celestial events but are visible only within a narrow path on Earth.

Monday, April 8, 2024



RESIDENT & VISITOR PREPARATIONS

- All Henry County schools will be closed.
- Expect road closures and traffic.
- Purchase personal food and toiletries in advance.
- Refuel vehicles.
- Obtain eclipse safety glasses.
- Consider pet safety.
- Expect limited internet & cell phone service.
- Prepare for eclipse visibility.

TRAVEL SAFETY

- Carry jumper cables, a spare tire, and emergency repair items in your vehicle.
- Pack plenty of shelf-stable snacks and bottled water.
- Carry cash for offline locations or service disruptions.
- Pack a physical map in case of a service outage.
- Bring functional charging cables and consider a portable battery.

VIEWING SAFETY

- Do not stare at the sun, and use eclipse safety glasses.
- Don't view through a telescope, camera, binoculars, or non-eclipse safety glasses.
- Teach children eclipse safety in advance of the event.
- Keep pets at home if possible and inside during the eclipse.

ECLIPSE ETIQUETTE

- Be respectful of state and local rules and regulations.
- Use designated viewing and parking areas only.
- Be considerate of other eclipse viewers so everyone can enjoy the event.
- Ensure you and everyone in your group have safe and sober transportation to designations.
- Be patient with delays and traffic flow.
- Use the "Leave No Trace" philosophy and clean up after yourselves.
